Edit Permissions


Changing owner/owner group, removing groups and adding groups can all be done on the Edit Permissions page

So how are effective permissions accumulated?






Virtual Permissions

Read Only View







Granular Rollback options, you are in control




List of items and folders to roll-back

Select target date, number of folder layers, what types of objects and what permission changes to process





Brava adds a custom set of permissions to Livelink. Depending on the settings these can consist of: "Download & Print", "Print in Brava!", "Publish & Redact", "Review Markups", "Create & Edit Markups", "Create Dynamic Stamps" and/or "Create Groupbased Views". The options below allow you to enable support for these permissions throughout the Permissions Manager functions.

Permissions Manager / Overview:	 True False Enable additional columns on the Permissions Manager / Overview page to show Brava Permissions.
Edit Permissions:	 True False Enable additional columns on the Edit Permissions page to handle Brava Permissions.
Replace User:	 True False Enable additional checkboxes on the Replace User page to handle Brava Permissions.


